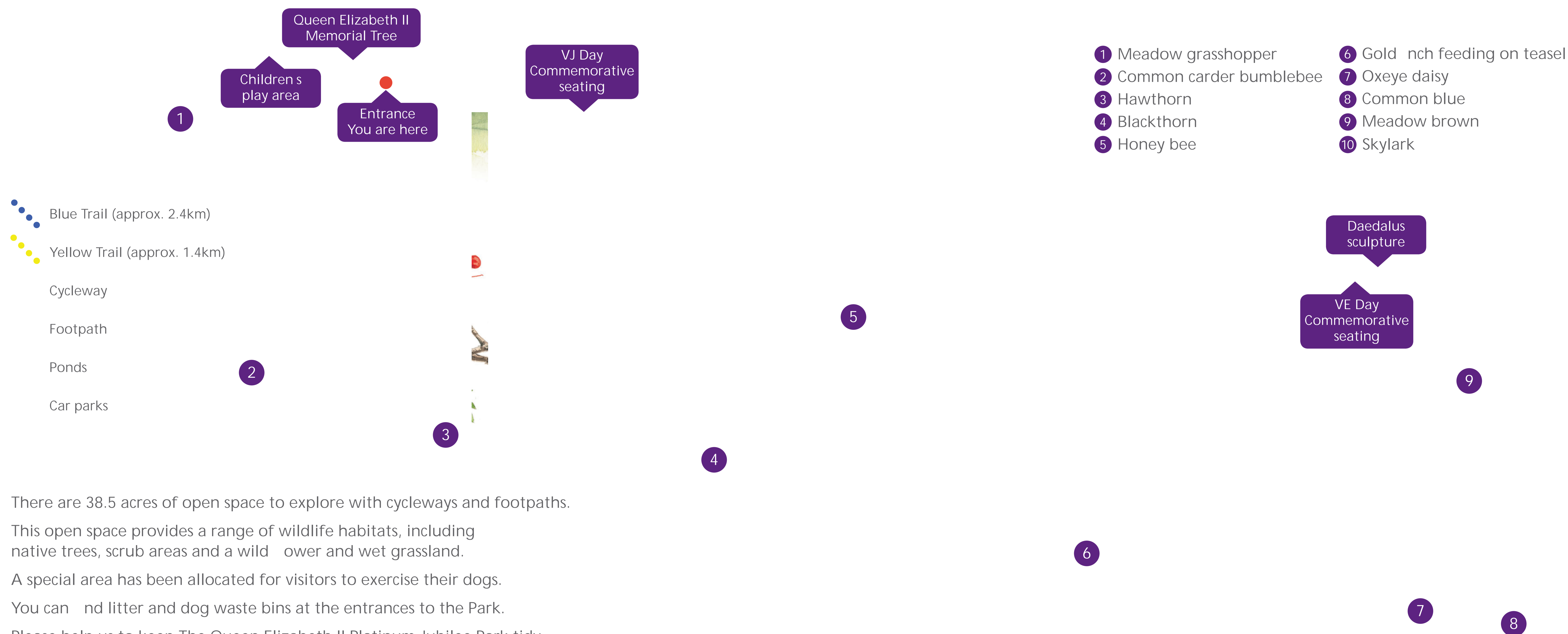


Welcome to Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Park

This open space provides a range of wildlife habitats, including native trees, scrub areas and a wildflower and wet grassland.

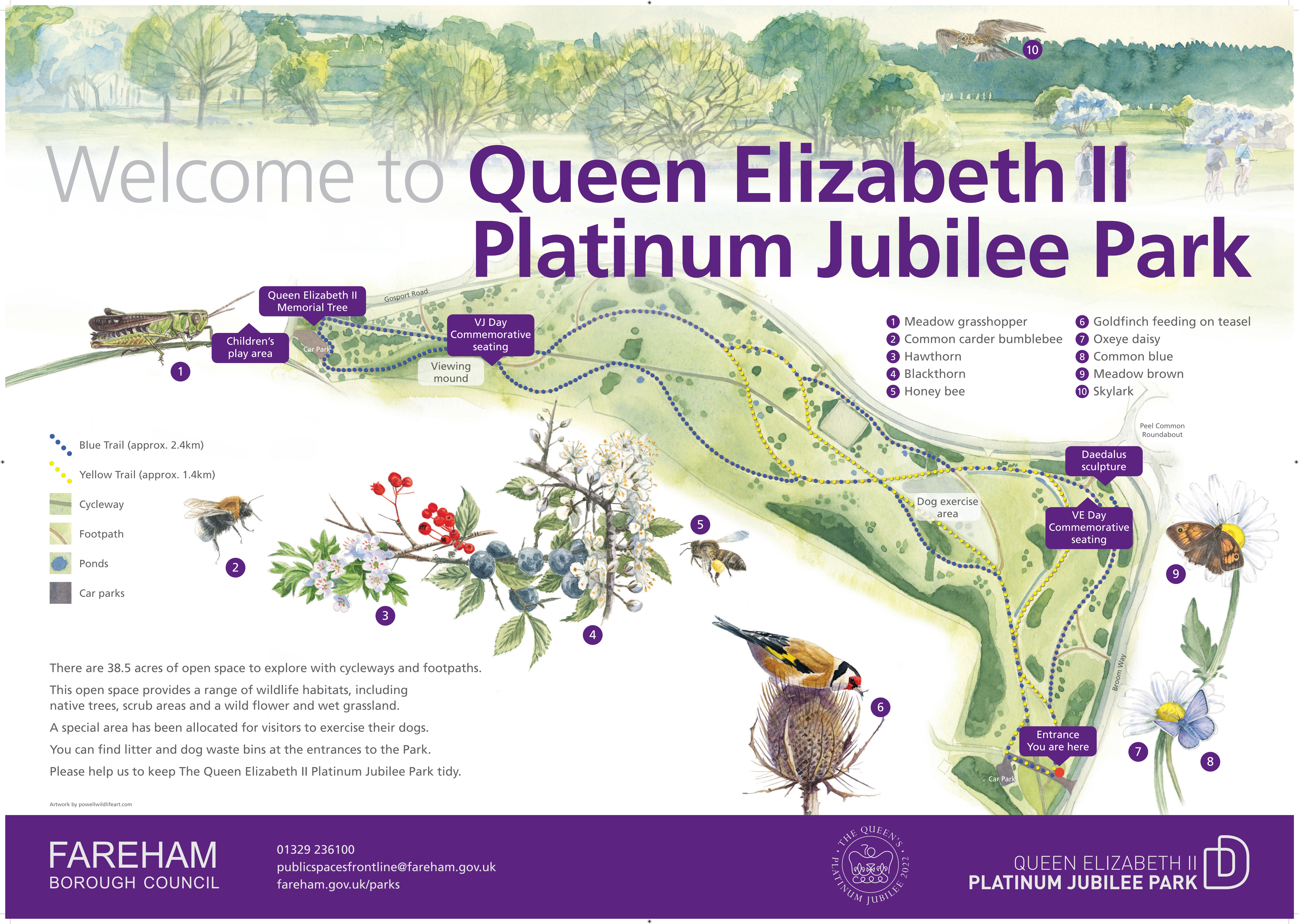
A special area has been allocated for visitors to exercise their dogs.
